Order a feast from our restaurant




Each meal can be paired with a wide assortment of beers, lagers, wines, spirits and soft drinks from the bar.



Can I supply my event with outside catering?

Am I allowed to bring my own DJ to an event?

Absolutely, providing we see proof of their public liability insurance and PAT testing prior to performing.

Am I allowed to dress the room myself?

Yes, providing you remove all decorations by 10.30am the following morning.

Can you cater for special dietary requirements?

Yes. If you have any requests, please call ahead or let us know in advance.

Are you a dog-friendly venue?

Yes, excepting Sundays and large parties.

What time does Squires 1892 at Kellington Manor close?

Usually around 1am, but it is negotiable.

Can you host themed parties?

Over the years, we've put on hundreds of children's parties and themed nights – like casino evenings. The only events we specifically don't cater to are hen or stag dos.
